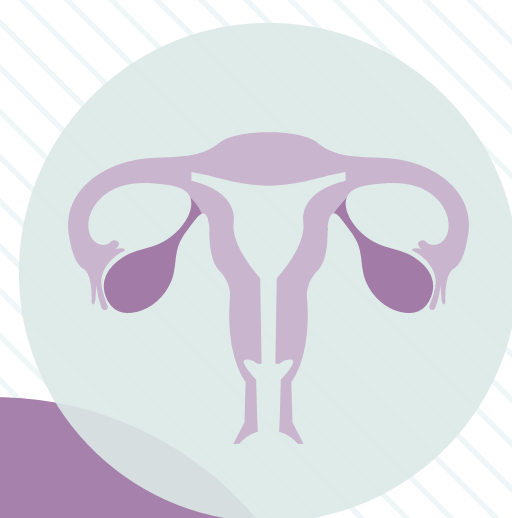


## What You Should Know About

# OVARIAN CANCER

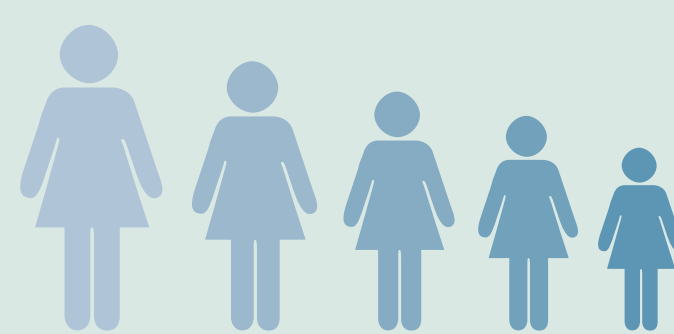
In 2017, about 22,440 women will receive a new diagnosis of ovarian cancer. This cancer mainly develops in older women and affects the ovaries in the reproductive system.

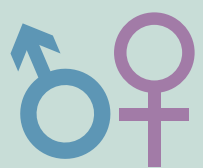

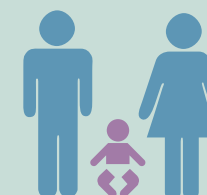
